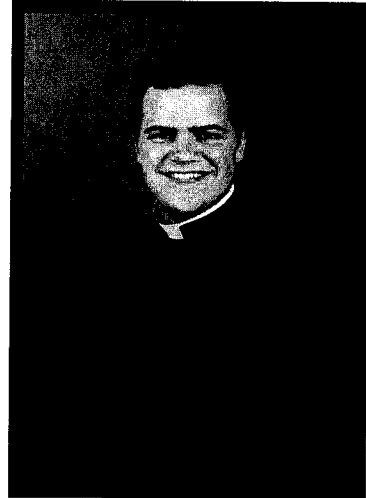


MEET OUR ADOPTED SEMINARIAN, SAMUEL MILLER!
