Since 2013, the MMOC Guardian Angel Outreach (GAO) has been working to assist parish families and individuals in need of economic assistance. The Angels started out by “adopting” one parish family that had experienced a sudden crisis. Slowly, additional families were identified and helped on an as-needed basis through this special behind-the-scenes program.

MMOC parishioners continue to be very generous with their financial support especially during our annual Poor Box Blitz (The 2017 Blitz total was \$6,251.75!!!).

- All monetary donations (cash and checks) marked for GAO and/or Blitz go directly to the MMOC Charitable Fund. This fund (distributed at the discretion of Father Tcheou) assists individuals/families in need with rent, utilities, etc.

- Your gift card donations are distributed directly to those parishioners in need via members of the GAO committee. Gift card donations help families purchase groceries, personal items, gas, etc.

We ask for your participation and continued support of the outreach by making donations of cash or checks (payable to MMOC with memo “Guardian Angels”). Gift card donations are another key way of assisting those in need. “Be An Angel Every Second” by making your donations on the Second weekend of every month. For your convenience, gift cards can be purchased via the MMOC SCRIP program. Simply stop at the SCRIP table after weekend Mass.

A collection box and envelopes are always available in the Narthex for your monetary and/or gift card donations.
